Installation on Debian-Based Systems

Qosium Scope can be installed by using the Debian package management system. This works in Ubuntu and other Debian-based Linux systems in Terminal or package manager applications, like Software Center and Synaptic.

1. Installation

First, <u>sign in</u> to your account and access <u>your downloads page</u>. Then download Qosium products for the target machine.

The name of the product file should have format <code>QosiumScope_<version_details>.deb</code>, for example <code>QosiumScope_Ubuntu_18.04_64_20200513.deb</code>.

To install a new copy, or to upgrade an existing one, open terminal and run

```
sudo dpkg -i QosiumScope_<version_details>.deb
```

After installation, you can check which version of Qosium Scope is installed by running:

dpkg -1 qosiumscope

2. Launching Scope

After installation, Scope can be launched by executing the following command in the terminal:

/opt/QosiumScope/bin/QosiumScope



Qosium Scope does not require root/sudo privileges.

3. Uninstallation

To remove Qosium Scope from the device, run:

sudo dpkg -r qosiumscope
